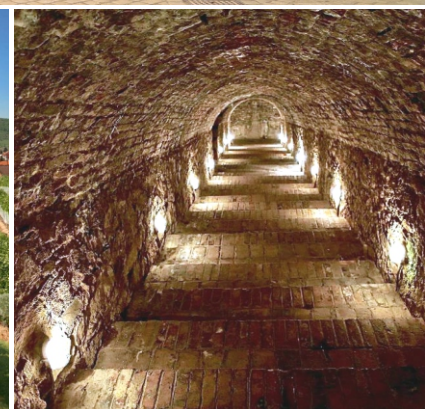
DAY 1
Arrival at Vienna airport. Meeting with English speaking guide. Transfer by lux bus to Bratislava, prior check-in at the hotel, panorama city tour of Bratislava with welcome drink on terrace with view on Danube river, possible to have a folk music performance during welcome drink. Check in at the hotel and free time at leisure. Dinner in classical restaurant in Bratislava what serves „Old Bratislava Cuisine“.

DAY 2
This day is dedicated to gastronomic tour of Bratislava. Gastronomy of Bratislava is mix of Hungarian, Austrian, Czech cuisine and Slovak cuisine as Bratislava lies on border lines with these countries. In the morning classical Slovakian breakfast at traditional café, where the guide will explain why breakfast is important for Slovaks. After the breakfast start of the walking tour in Bratislava with break for coffee & cake. Coffee & Cake can be replaced by wine tasting. Continue of walking tour in beautiful historical city center of Bratislava, you will see during the tour all main highlights of Bratislava- The Opera House, Reduta Building, Franciscan Church, Primate's Palace, Old Town Hall, St. Michael's Gate, Palace of Hungarian parliament, Academia Istropolitana and St. Martin's Cathedral. Lunch in fine restaurant in city center (3 course menu with drink). After the lunch possible to have a beer

degustation in local small brewery. In afternoon free time at leisure. Dinner in restaurant popular among local people.

DAY 3
Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Visit of Small Carpathian Wine Route, the most famous wine growing region out of eight Slovakian wine regions. At first entrance to fairytale Red Stone Castle. Afterwards stop in wine city Modra, which is also well known thanks to production of traditional Slovakian pottery- Majolika and as a birthplace of Slovak National hero Ludevít Stur. Visit of local small Majolika handcraft manufacture with workshop. Transfer to "Capital City" of Slovak wine production. Lunch at stylish Pezinok castle with wine tasting in stylish wine cellars. Or as an alternative is possible to organize outdoor team building activity, like very popular wild rafting in Bratislava, or education physical activities like palying ice hockey, curling or other sport activities. In the evening gala dinner at palace or at restaurant with panoramic view.

DAY 4
Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Vienna. Possible to get to Vienna from Bratislava also by river cruise. During the week possible to change visit of Vienna to shopping at Outlet Parndorf Shopping Factory or to visit famous chocolate factory in Kittssee with chocolate degustation.

Arrival at Vienna airport. Meeting with English speaking guide at Vienna airport. Transfer to Bratislava. Prior check-in at the hotel, panorama city tour of Bratislava on bus. Check-in at the hotel and free time for a lunch. After the lunch walking tour in historical city center of Bratislava- St. Martin's Cathedral, The Opera House, Reduta Building, Primate's Palace, Central Square, St. Michael's Gate. In late afternoon dinner in restaurant. Overnight in Bratislava.

Day 2

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and departure to Nitra, the oldest city of Slovakia. Visit of beautiful city center of Nitra with entrance to Nitra Castle with St. Emeram Cathedral. Lunch in Nitra. Possible to have for a surcharge degustation of local peculiarity – mead. Continue to Hronsky Benadikt Abbey, one of the most beautiful buildings of Slovakia. Entrance to monastery. Continue to Banska Stiavnica, former mining city. Visit of city center (UNESCO) and possible entrances to Old Castle of Banska Stiavnica and to St. Kathrin's Church. Continue to Banska Bystrica, overnight in Banska Bystrica.

Day 3

Buffet breakfast and departure to

Hronsek, entrance to lutheran wooden church, which was built without using any nail (UNESCO). Continue to Banska Bystrica, center of Central Slovakia, during II. World War the center of Slovak National Uprising. Lunch in Banska Bystrica. Departure towards Low Tatras. En route stop in Vlkolinec (UNESCO), traditional Slovakian wooden village, which is still inhabited. Arrival in Low Tatras, famous SKI/ Summer resort. Check in at the hotel, short stroll along Vrbické Pleso, only glacier lake in Low Tatras. Dinner and overning in Low Tatras.

Day 4

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, entrance to Demanovska Cave of Liberty. Afterwards departure towards High Tatras, stroll along the Strbske Pleso, glacier lake and the highest village of Slovakia. Lunch in typical Slovakian restaurant- Koliba. Arrival in Stary Smokovec, from where we take a funicular to Hrebienok. Short stroll in Hrebienok. Dinner in Koliba Stara Lesna. Overnight in High Tatras.

Day 5

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Tatranska Lomnica, from where we will take a cable car to

second highest peak of Slovakia – Lomnický Peak. Lunch in High Tatras region. Afterwards departure to Spiss Region, region famous thanks to gothic buildings. Entrance Spiss Castle (UNESCO) and Slovakian Vatican Spisska Kapitula with catedral of St. Martin (UNESCO). Arrival in Kosice, dinner and overnight in Kosice.

Day 6

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Stroll in historical city center of Kosice with possible entrance to St. Elisabeth Cathedral. Departure towards Bardejov, with beautiful medieval square with St. Egidius Cathedral (UNESCO). In Bardejov also possible entrance to museum of icons. En route to Presov we will visit Wooden Churches in Hervartov and Trocany. Continue to Presov, stroll in historical city center. Dinner and overnight in Presov.

Day 7

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure towards Levoca, with entrance to St. Jacob Cathedral with unique wooden altar of Master Paul from Levoca (UNESCO). Afterwards continue to medieval city Kezmarok. Visit of beautiful city center with possible entrances to

city castle and wooden church. Continue to Orava region, with possible entrance to fairytale Orava Castle. Prior the entrance lunch in castle area. Departure towards Zilina, dinner and overnight in Zilina.

Day 8

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, visit of Zilina historical city center. Afterwards departure towards Trenčín. Visit of historical city center. Continue to Trnava, which is also known as "Small Rome", or "Slovakian Rome". Visit of historical city center and possible entrance to St. Nicolas Cathedral. Lunch in Trnava. Continue to Small Carpathian Wine Route, one of the eight wine regions of Slovakia. Possible entrance to Red Stone Castle. Continue to wine cities Modra & Pezinok. Wine dinner and wine tasting at stylish wine cellar. Overnight in Bratislava.

Day 9

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, Transfer to Vienna airport. En route to Vienna possible to stop in Kittsee Chocolate Factory or in Pardorf Outlet Shopping Factory (for surcharge).

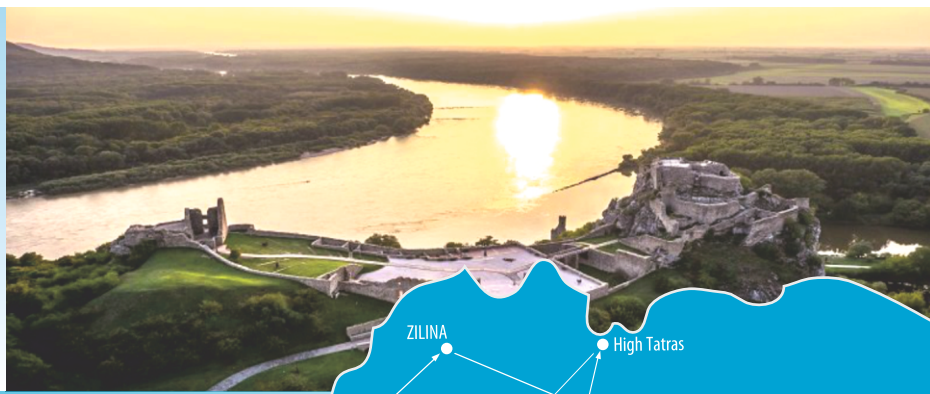

Arrival at Vienna airport (45 km from Bratislava), or at Bratislava airport. Transfer to your hotel in Bratislava. If you have a free time in afternoon, you can contact us regarding the city tour in Bratislava. Overnight in Bratislava.

Day 2

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and departure to Piešťany- famous SPA city, possible to have a treatment at SPA. Continue to Beckov Castle. Arrival in Trenčín- center of West Slovakia. Stroll in historical city center with possibility to entrance to monumental Trenčín castle above the city. Afterwards stop in Cicmany, the traditional Slovakian village with wooden houses painted with white patterns. Last stop in Rajecká Lesná, pilgrimage place with wooden crèche which shows traditions and habits of Slovakia. In afternoon arrival in Zilina. Overnight in Zilina.

Day 3

Buffet breakfast at hotel, check-out and departure towards the most famous village of Slovakia- Terchova. The Terchova music is part of UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE, and Terchova is well know also thanks to unspoiled nature and as birth place of Slovak National hero Juraj Janosik (Slovakian Robin Hood). Continue to Vrátna Valley, where is possible to take a cable car to Snilovské Peak. Afterwards continue to Orava Region. Entrance to fairytale Orava Castle. Continue to Vlkolinec, traditional Slovakian village (UNESCO). Arrival in Demanovská valley, possible entrance to Demanovská Cave of Liberty. Accommodation in Liptovský Mikuláš.

Day 4

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and departure to High Tatras, the highest mountains in Slovakia. Stroll along Strbské Pleso glacier lake. Strbské Pleso is also climatic SPA. Continue to Starý Smokovec and Tatranská Lomnica mountain villages, Spišská Sobota the historical city center of Poprad. Possible to relax at AquaCity Poprad. For Tatras's region are typical restaurants Koliba with

traditional Slovakian plates- Bryndzové Halušky (Slovakian gnocchi with sheep cheese and bacon). Overnight in High Tatras.

Day 5

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and departure to Spiš region, which is famous thanks to big amount of gothic monuments, a part of them are also part of UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE. Visit of Spiš Castle (UNESCO), Slovakian Vatican Spišská Kapitula Abbey (UNESCO), medieval city Kežmarok with city castle. Continue to center of Central Slovakia- Banská Bystrica, during II. World War the center of Slovak National Uprising. Stroll in historical city center. Overnight in Banská Bystrica.

Day 6

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, departure to Hronsek, where is located wooden church which was built without using any nail. Continue to Zvolen with city castle and afterwards to Banská Stiaňnica, in past the famous mining city, stroll in historical city center (UNESCO). Possible to visit the Open air mining museum. Overnight in Banská Stiaňnica

Day 7

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure towards Nitra, the oldest city of Slovakia, with beautiful city center with Nitra Castle and St. Emeram Cathedral above the city. Continue to Trnava, which is famous also under nick names as "Slovakian Rome" or "Small Rome", thanks to a great volume of sacral buildings. Possible visit basilica of St. Nicolas and Cathedral of John Baptist. Continue to Red Stone Castle which is located in the most famous wine region of Slovakia – Small Carpathian Wine Road. Continue to Modra and Pezínok famous wine cities. Moreover wine production these cities are famous also thanks to production of traditional Slovakian pottery – Majolika. Arrival in Bratislava. Overnight in Bratislava.

Day 8

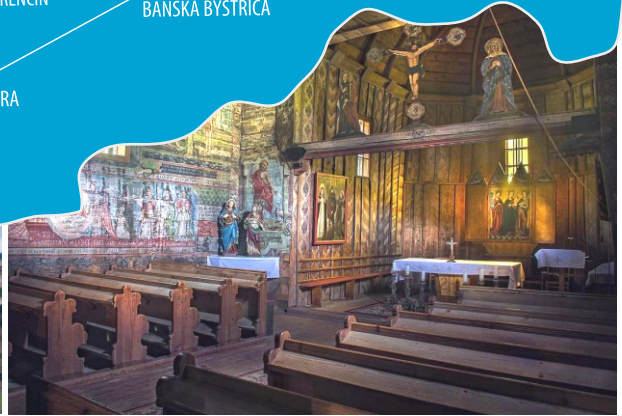
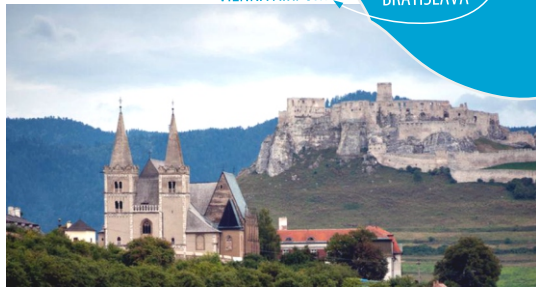

RELIGIOUS SLOVAKIA WOODEN CHURCHES

8 DAYS / 7 NIGHTS

Day 1

Arrival at Vienna airport. Transfer to Bratislava. En route stop in pilgrimage place Marianka, the oldest pilgrimage site of Slovakia, visit of the church of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary from 1380 year. Check in at the hotel and walking tour in historical city center of Bratislava. Entrance to St. Matrin's Cathedral, where were coronated 18 Hungarian kings and queens. Visit of Blue Church of Bratislava too. Last stop at calvary of Bratislava, which was built after the battle of Vienna between Otaman Empire and Austro-Hungarian Empire. Visit of church of Virgin Mary of the snow. Overnight in Bratislava

Day 2

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Visit of one of the oldest building of Slovakia- the Devin Castle, where worked and lived St. Cyril & Method, who brought Christianity to Slovakia and who created first Slavic script- Hlaholika. Continue to pilgrimage place Sastin, and entrance to cathedral of Our Lady of Seven Sorrows. The Lady of Seven Sorrows is also patron of Slovakia. Continue to Skalica, a city located on frontier with Czech Republic, stroll in historical city center of Skalica, entrance to City House what was designed by the most famous Slovakian architect Dusan Jurkovic. Entrance to Franciscan church of Our Lady of Seven Sorrows and Rotunda

of St. Michael Archangel. Return back to Bratislava. Overnight in Bratislava.

Day 3

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Trnava a residence of archbishop, the city is also well know under the nicknames "Small Rome" or "Slovakian Rome" thanks to a great amount of sacral buildings. Entrance to St. Nicolas Basilica and to St. John Baptist Cathedral. Short stroll in historical city center along the Holy Trinity Square. Continue to pilgrimage site Skalka near Trencin where saints Andrej & Svorad Benedikt lived. Continue to a peak Budkov, the new pilgrimage site in Slovakia built just in 2012. Continue to Marian pilgrimage site Rajeccka Lesna, entrance to basilica of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary and visit of the biggest wooden crèche in Slovakia which shows habits and handicrafts of Slovakia. Transfer to Zilina. Overnight in Zilina.

Day 4

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, visit of historical center of Zilina with Cathedral of Holy Trinity and Virgen Mary square. Continue to Trnove, entrance to wooden church of St. Joseph from 15th century. Continue to Terchova, the most famous Slovakian village thanks to unique nature and landscape and folklore traditions. Terchova's music is part of

UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE.

Entrance to church of St. Cyril & Method with small wooden crèche. Short stroll in Vratna Valley. Afterwards entrance to wooden church in Lestiny and continue to Vlkolinec (UNESCO), the traditional Slovakian village. Stop at church of Saint Cross, wooden church which was built without using any nail. Arrival at Low Tatras. Overnight in Low Tatras region.

Day 5

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, entrance to Demanovska Cave of Liberty. Departure towards High Tatras, stroll along the Strbske Pleso glacier lake also the highest village of Slovakia. Visit of mountains villages Tatranska Lomnica & Stary Smokovec. Transfer to medieval city Kezmarok with basilica Saint Cross and possible entrance to wooden Lutheran church as well as city castle. Continue to another medieval city Levoca.

Day 6

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and stroll along historical city center of Levoca with basilica of St. Jacob with unique altar of Maestro Paul from Levoca (UNESCO). Afterwards visit of pilgrimage place peak of Virgen Maria. Continue to Bardejov (UNESCO) with beautiful square with St. Egidius cathedral. Continue to

Hervartov & Trocany, visit of wooden churches (UNESCO). En route to Kosice stop in Presov with entrance to co-cathedral of St. Nicolas. Arrival in Kosice. Overnight in Kosice.

Day 7

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Walking tour in historical city center of Kosice with entrance to cathedral of St. Elisabeth. Continue to Zehra with church of Holly Spirit from 12. century with unique frescos. Continue to Slovak Vatican- Spisska Kapitula Abbey with cathedral of St. Martin (UNESCO). Afterwards possible entrance to Spiss Castle (UNESCO), the biggest castle in Central Europe. Last stop in Stare Hory with basilica of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Arrival in Banska Bystrica, overnight.

Day 8

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Short stroll in historical city center of Banska Bystrica with cathedral of St. Francis. Continue to Hronsek (UNESCO), where is located Lutheran wooden church which was built without using any nail. Continue to Nitra, the oldest Slovakian city where was located the first church in Slovakia. Visit of historical city center with Nitra Castle with cathedral of St. Emeram. Departure towards Vienna airport.

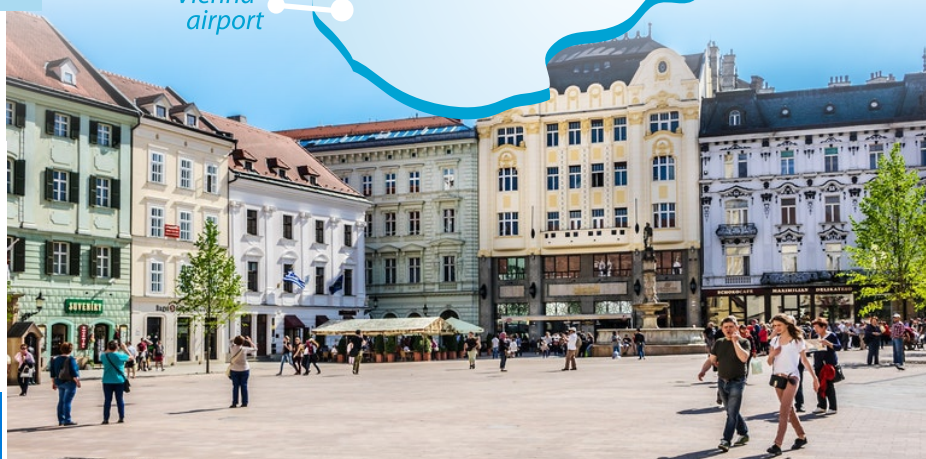
